



ART DISPLAY **CALL FOR ENTRIES**

The Asotin County Library hosts art displays at its downtown branch located at 417 Sycamore St, Clarkston, WA. The primary purpose of the art displayed is to enrich the library experience of Library patrons and visitors and, particularly, to enhance and increase community appreciation of the arts, present a variety of exhibitions by area artists, and help local and regional artists increase their public exposure.

Exhibits are chosen by a committee with final approval given by the Library Board of Trustees and Library Director.

SUBMISSIONS

Applications are accepted until spaces are filled; expect written acknowledgment of receipt within two (2) weeks. Further notice regarding acceptance or rejection will be determined by the meeting schedule of the art committee.

Displays are generally scheduled at least three (3) to six (6) months in advance.

Complete and return an "Art Display Application" along with three (3) examples of your work (slides, photographs, color copies, digital samples, etc.) and a typed resume or biographical paragraph to:
